Mrs. Imogene Westmoreland Hoard McCants, age 87, of Watkinsville, GA died Wednesday, August 15, 2018 at Kindred Hospice. Mrs. McCants was born in Jefferson to the late George Washington and Macie Fambrough Westmoreland. She was a member of Tuckston United Methodist Church and was retired from the University of Georgia Alumni House.
