Mr. Steven Dale Baxter, age 66, of Maysville, GA died Thursday, January 16, 2020 at Northridge Medical Center. Mr. Baxter was born in Commerce to the late Joe T. and Helen Freada Anglin Baxter. He was a veteran of the United States Navy and served during the Vietnam era. His father and siblings also served in the United States Armed Forces. Mr. Baxter was the manager of Radio Shack. 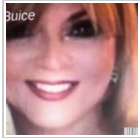
