*We will miss everything about Steven Including his adventurous spirit, his ambitious and enthusiastic nature, His gift of comedy and warmth we will surely miss.*

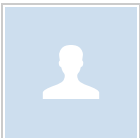
*We know he left this world too young but until we meet again Steven, we hold you in our hearts forever and ever looking forward to*

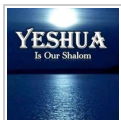

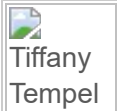
