It is truly a pound cake.*

1 lb. butter

10 eggs

5 T. lemon juice

4 c. flour

3 1/2 c. sugar

Cream butter, mix in flour slowly. Beat egg yolks and add sugar gradually. Add lemon juice. Beat egg whites stiff. Combine butter mixture with sugar mixture. Last of all add stiffly beaten egg whites.

Bake at 275 to 300 degrees for 1 1/2 hours or until well. done.

Be sure to use an extra large tube pan!!! It is an extremely good cake.
